OLIFE TEEN

Our next LifeTEEN night will be on Saturday April 6 following the 5pm Mass. All Grade 9-12's are invited for a great evening of fun, food, and prayer. Come out and give it try.

Today with our Palm Sunday celebration we have already entered the Holy Week, which will be completed in Triduum. Triduum which literally means three days will be lasting from Thursday till Saturday night. Though it seems it involves three separated liturgies, in fact it is a one long liturgy. The liturgy of Holy Thursday has no 'ending' – there is no final blessing or dismissal. Instead, we are invited to remain and "watch and wait with Jesus" before the Blessed Sacrament. Good Friday's Service has no 'opening' or 'closing' but contains the Liturgy of the Word, the Veneration of the Cross and the receiving of Holy Communion. consecrated at the Holy Thursday Mass. Then we move into the holiest celebration of all and the culmination of the Triduum: the Easter Vigil.

Holy Thursday we let the Lord wash our feet, we symbolizes the depth of His servitude toward us. On Good Friday we ponder, reflect and adore Jesus's sacrifice. The Easter Vigil is the most important Eucharist of a year, "mother of all the Eucharists", celebrated in the holy night when all people of faith are eagerly awaiting the resurrection of our Lord. Only that night we light and bless the Paschal candle symbolizing that the Lord is light. We sing magnificent "Preaconium Paschale", "Exsultet" a hymn of the ancient origins revoking the wonders of God's love. That night we don't rush, we stay awake, we delight in abundance of God's word. That night the entire parish united renews its baptism promises, but also baptizes catechumens, and receives Christian candidates into full communion with the Church. And in that night triumphant "Alleluia" will announce to the world that the Lord is truly risen and he has conquered death and sin. In order to prepare ourselves for such important feast the Church invites us to fast

on Good Friday. The bare minimum is to have two small meals, and one normal but those who can Church invites to do more. To be in silence, without entertainment, fasting as much as one can - the bridegroom has been taken away from us and we fast. Holy Saturday is also a fasting day. Our Lord is buried and we refuse to be consoled. Finally, the Easter Vigil arrives when Jesus words are fulfilled: "I tell you the solemn truth, you will weep and wail, but the world will rejoice; you will be sad, but your sadness will turn into joy." We invite you strongly and encourage you to live Triduum as it deserves - as a peak

of our Christian life expressed in beautiful liturgies. As Jesus has invited His disciples to stay and pray with Him, so we are asked to be with the Lord in the most important of times.
